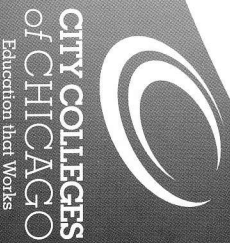


HOW TO ENROLL?

EARNING COLLEGE CREDIT IS FREE!

Through a partnership with Chicago Public Schools (CPS) and City Colleges of Chicago, the cost of tuition and laboratory fees will be covered for participating students taking any of the following courses:

- Business

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- ✓ Earn credit for both high school and college. The college credit will be applied to a degree program at one of the City Colleges of Chicago or can be transferred to a four-year college.
- ✓ Access to great college professors.
- ✓ Develop important time management and study skills.

HOW DO YOU QUALIFY?

- ✓ Be a junior or senior in high school
- ✓ Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- ✓ Have a 90% attendance rate in your high school
- ✓ Have an ACT reading score of at least 19 and a math score of at least 21 or a COMPASS reading score of 80 and a math score of at least 43.
- ✓ Submit a signed parental permission form
